What are we learning about in Autumn Term 2025?

English:

- For the first week, we will be reading 'The Kindness Tree' and using it as stimulus for Composition. We will start our novel study: 'Orphans of the Tide' by Struan Murray in our Reading lessons.
- For the remainder of Autumn one 'Orphans of the Tide' will be used in Composition and Reading lessons.

Maths:

- Initially, we are learning about place value and understanding the value of the digits within numbers up to 10,000,000.
- We will then be completing work on the four operations – addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will use written and mental methods to complete calculations.

Science:

- We will be focusing on 'rocks and caves'.

History and Geography:

- In Geography, we will be focusing on Volcanoes. We will look at dormant, extinct and active volcanoes around the world.

PE:

- In PE, we will be following 'GetSet4PE' where we will be working on areas of personal development and fitness. We will also have a weekly lesson based on 'Invasion Games'.



Art/Design and technology:

- For Art lessons, we will be designing and creating Roman pottery.

RE/PSHE:

- In RE, we are beginning by learning about Christianity. Our focus will be “What does it mean if Christians believe God is holy and loving?”
- In PSHE, we will be discussing how to manage friendships healthily.

Computing:

- We are using Purple Mash to build on our knowledge of coding.

Spanish:

- ‘I am learning Spanish’ where we will learn about Spain and learn key Spanish vocabulary as well as basic Spanish phrases. We will also be learning how to communicate about each of the seasons.

Music:

- Following Music Express, we will be exploring how Music effects communities and looking at music in our local community.
